

Grave Creek, MT Restoration Tours in 2004, 2006, 2007 and 2010 - Celebrating multi-year Stream Restoration projects at Flannagan's Ranch just South of Eureka, Montana.



Mainstreams and Kootenai River Network (Libby MT) organized a series of International Stream Restoration Tours from 2004 until 2010.

These workshops included Government agents, Consultants, Environmental Stewardship groups, Business, Industry and Interested citizens.

They showcased stream restoration work in Montana, Idaho and B.C.

Therriault Wetlands, MT - drained and filled during the 1940s, the owners needed help to restore these wetlands.



Goat River, BC Kenton Andreashuk (Canadian Columbia River International Fisheries Commission) guided the tour, which focused on in-stream revetments to mitigate erosion at critical points on the Goat River.



Joseph Creek, Cranbrook BC - This tour focused on an in-stream restoration project on Joseph Creek at Kinsmen Park, Cranbrook in 2006. Mainstreams coordinated this \$65,000 project, but it was the brainchild of the Joseph Creek Community Action team which formed in August 2003 when Joseph Creek ran dry.



We began the Tour at Fort Steele, where Joe Pierre told the Ktunaxa Creation Myth, then the tour went on to Kinsmen Park and ended at Elizabeth Lake, to view the trail restoration work by the Rocky Mountain Naturalists.
