

Mainstreams Spring 2019 program is cancelled.

Because of lack of funding, Mainstreams is cancelling our spring 2019 program. If current fund raising efforts are successful, we will offer limited programs beginning in May 2019. Mainstreams hopes that our regular programs will be in full operation by mid-June 2019.

Mainstreams is adding a second Climate Change Program!

Since last fall, a Mainstreams Board Committee has been working with Dave Quinn on the design of a follow-up to our Climate Change Adaptation Program in the Kootenays. This effort has been funded by a 2018 Fortis BC grant.

The new program "Climate Change in the Kootenays 2.0: Living with Wildfire" is in the final draft stage. Mainstreams hopes to pilot the new program in May.

Each year, all East Kootenay teachers arrange a conference. Mainstreams has been asked to do a presentation about Climate Change in the Kootenays 2.0 Living With Fire. This program and all others being considered for the conference will be voted on by all teachers. If our program makes the cut, Mainstreams will carry out this presentation.
